- Henry Community Health has set up an <u>outdoor</u>, <u>drive-through Respiratory Clinic</u> for patients who may have flu, strep, or COVID-19. Open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. seven days a week. Patients must call ahead: 765-599-3443.
- If you have a fever or are experiencing respiratory symptoms, CALL YOUR PHYSICIAN PRIOR to attending any previously scheduled appointments, including testing.
- This is a rapidly evolving situation. We will continue to monitor the latest developments and update procedures and policies as necessary. Our Infection Prevention team and hospital leaders are meeting regularly to ensure we are prepared to safely identify, isolate, and care for patients who meet the latest Indiana State Department of Health and CDC criteria for COVID-19 testing.

- Walmart is open from 7 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Tuesdays until April 28 and offers senior shopping for customers aged 60 and older: one hour before the store opens.
- Kroger offers grocery delivery in New Castle for a nominal fee.
- CVS Pharmacy offers prescription delivery and 90-day prescription fills on most medications.
